

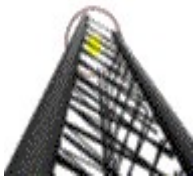


THE 17th ANNUAL SALEM AMATEUR

The repeaters also provide communications for several fund raising events involving "walks" or "rides" around the local countryside. This aids in traffic control and safety for these participants and motorists.
